Teen Counselor in Training Program

A \$110 application fee is required, which will cover a mandatory background screening issued by Department of Children and Families, a t-shirt, and processing fee.

The Teen Counselor in Training program is a summer program. Applications for the program are accepted in early spring.

This is an ideal opportunity for teens between the ages of 15-17 who are looking for an enriching summer work experience. Volunteers should be motivated and enthusiastic about outdoor education, recreation, science, and history! To be considered for the program, individuals must complete an application, including two letters of recommendation from a teacher or counselor by the deadline date, attend an orientation session, attend all training classes and successfully pass an exam, and background screening before being assigned to a position.

Participants in this program will gain hands-on experience in working within a nationally accredited museum. In addition, the Teen Counselor in Training program provides an opportunity to make new friends, explore careers in cultural arts and sciences, accumulate community service hours required for graduation and scholarships, and earn a letter of recommendation for a job well done!

Teen Counselors in Training will:

- Engage campers in games, songs, and activities
- Assist camp teachers with set up of activities
- Participate in educational programs that are offered to campers
- Assist camp teachers on field trips
- Have an exciting and enriching summer!
