Museum Manners

Chaperones are to be with students of all ages at all times. Groups that allow children to

- 1. roam without a chaperone will be asked to leave the Museum. Additionally, student backpacks are not allowed in the Museum Gift Shop.
- 2. Help protect the animals' health by keeping treats for yourself and small items out of habitats.
- 3. For your safety and the animals' safety, stay out of the animal enclosures. Please do not climb on the fences or sit on the railings.
- 4. Remain quiet while walking through the Museum's Florida Wildlife Trail to see more animals. Help the animals remain calm by using soft voices while in this area.
- 5. Protect historic buildings, artifacts and displays by keeping your food outdoors, or in the picnic areas.
- 6. Keep the Museum a beautiful, natural place to visit by putting your trash in the appropriate bins.
- 7. Plants and critters are here for all to enjoy. Look with your eyes, not your hands.

Program Payment Information

- 1. Program reservations are made on a first come, first served basis.
- 2. Program fees are due upon booking in order to secure a date and time (PO will suffice).
- 3. All program fees are for groups of 25 individuals, with up to 10 additional individuals at \$5 per person. Group leaders must have an accurate head-count of program participants on the day your group visits. If the number of program participants exceeds the program amount paid, your group will be billed for the balance.
- 4. Cancellation of a program results in a refund of the program fee, minus a processing fee of \$25, to be issued to those groups canceling up to two business (Monday-Friday) prior to their visit.
- 5. No-shows and cancellations made during the two business day period prior to the scheduled visit will forfeit, or be billed, the entire program fee.
- 6. The Museum reserves the right to cancel a program if a group is not ready to begin their program at the scheduled time. The Museum does not offer refunds for late arrivals.
- 7. The Museum does not cancel programs because of rain. Please come prepared for inclement weather. If necessary, the Museum will substitute a program.
